ORED TO A PART OF THE PROGRAM IN WHICH I FEEL HIGHLY HONORED TO PARTICIPATE, THE PRESENTATION OF THE PAST-PRESIDENT'S PIN
TO OUR GOOD FRIEND, ALBERT B. CRAIG. ALBERT HAS ALWAYS INSISTED
UPON BREVITY AND COMING TO THE POINT. IF WE FOLLOW THAT PATTERN
AND LIMIT OUR WORDS TO WHAT MIGHT APPEAR UNDER THE SPACE LIMITATIONS OF A SMALL PLAQUE OR SCROLL, I PRESUME THE VERY BRIEFEST

- 1-19-21....FIRST REGISTRATION, A SON OF HIS FIRST COW.
- 5-30-21....BECAME MEMBER OF THE HOLSTEIN-FRIESIAN ASSOCIA-TION OF AMERICA.
- 2-27-25....RESERVED "CRACLA" PREFIX. 193 FEMALES, 57 MALES HAVE BORNE THIS PREFIX.
- 1934.....ELECTED DIRECTOR OF THE HOLSTEIN-FRIESIAN ASSO-CIATION OF AMERICA.
- 1936......ELECTED MEMBER OF THE FINANCE COMMITTEE.
- 1937......ELECTED CHAIRMAN OF THE FINANCE COMMITTEE, AND CONTINUING IN THAT CAPACITY TO 1950.
- 1946-1950...MEMBER OF THE RULES COMMITTEE, ALSO A MEMBER 1953-1955.
- 1953-1955...VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE HOLSTEIN-FRIESIAN ASSOCIA-TION OF AMERICA.

\*FOR ONE WHOSE FAME MIGHT SEEM TO REST UPON HIS ORGANIZATIONAL EFFORTS, A VISITOR FROM MARS MIGHT INQUIRE, \*YES, BUT WHAT HAS HE DONE AS A BREEDER IN HIS OWN HERD?\* WE ARE WILLING TO LET THE RECORD SPEAK FOR ITSELF....THE TWO GREATEST TOOLS OF BREED IM-PROVEMENT HAVE BEEN HERD IMPROVEMENT REGISTRY AND HERD CLASSIFICATION, THE FORMER RECORDING FOR PRODUCTION OF MILK AND FAT WHAT THE LATTER DOES FOR BODY TYPE. WHAT HAVE BEEN HIS ACCOMPLISHMENTS HERE? ALBERT HAS BEEN ON HERD IMPROVEMENT REGISTRY TWENTY-EIGHT YEARS. THE PROGRAM, ITSELF, HAS BEEN IN EFFECT ONLY TWENTY-NINE YEARS, SO HE HAS FEW CONTEMPORARIES. HIS LATEST PUBLISHED HERD AVERAGE IS: 14048 LBS. MILK, 4% TEST, 564.4 LBS. FAT. IN THE FIELD OF CLASSIFICATION HIS LATEST PUBLISHED SCORE SHOWS: 2 EXCELLENT; 13 VERY GOOD; 9 GOOD PLUS; 2 GOOD, FOR AN OUTSTANDING CLASSIFICATION SCORE, ALL THE MORE REMARKABLE BECAUSE FOR TWENTY-FIVE YEARS OR MORE, ALL ANIMALS WITH THE EXCEPTION OF CERTAIN SIRES HAVE BEEN STRICTLY HOME-BRED. THE HIGHEST AWARD OUR ASSOCIATION CAN CONFER ON A BREEDER, PROGRESS—
IVE BREEDER'S REGISTRY, A TOTAL OF THIRTEEN TIMES. IN OUR TYPE AND
PRODUCTION BOOK ALMOST 9000 HERDS HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED HERD NUMBERS,
INDICATING CLASSIFIED AND TESTED ANIMALS. ONLY THREE OF THESE HERDS
HAVE RECEIVED THE PROGRESSIVE BREEDER'S REGISTRY AWARD A GREATER NUMBER OF TIMES. TO BE ONE OF THE TOP FOUR AMONG SO MANY IS SOMETHING
FOR WHICH ALBERT MUST BE TREMENDOUSLY PROUD."

I CAN THINK OF NO ONE WHO CAN WEAR THE PAST-PRESIDENT'S PIN WITH GREATER OR MORE PARDONABLE PRIDE. ACCEPT IT AS A TOKEN OF OUR APPRECIATION AND OF OUR AFFECTION.
